Students will be given four lessons to work on this essay in and class and further work is required at home. Students will be given a sample essay and scaffold to assist.</p> <p>Question: Outline the role of women in Greek society and how is this reflected in myths.</p> <p>Your response must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reference to both primary and secondary sources (Part A) • Outlining the role of women in society (part B) • Evaluate how the role of women is reflected in myths (Part C) • <p>Bibliography: Ensure there is a clear provision of a bibliography.</p>
