


CSMN Wifi: Apple Mac OS Configuration Advice

The following information details how to setup Apple Mac OS desktops and laptops (e.g. iMacs and MacBooks) for connection to the “CSMN” wireless networks.

1. Click on the wireless icon  and select ‘CSMN’ in the network list.
2. Enter your network username/password and diocese and click ‘Login’.



Note: You may need to launch ‘Safari’ before the wifi authentication page is displayed.

3. Launch ‘Safari’ web browser and enter the following address:
<http://mnconnect.cloud/zscaler>
4. Safari will download the certificate file to the ‘Downloads’ container. Click on ‘Downloads’ on the task bar and select ‘zscaler-root-2048-SHA256.crt’:



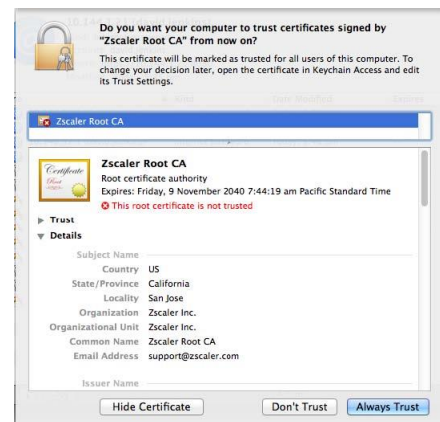
5. Select ‘Keychain: System’ and click ‘Add’:



6. Enter the name/password of an administrator account on the device and click ‘Modify Keychain’:



7. Open the System folder from the list on the left of the screen. Find the zscaler file and double click it. Confirm that you wish to trust the certificate by selecting ‘Always Trust’.



8. Enter the administrator account name/password again and click ‘Update Settings’:



9. You will now be connected to the wireless network and have Internet access.
