## College Fees 2025

## **COLLEGE FEES**

College fees, as determined by the Diocesan Catholic Schools Board, for Resource, Tuition and Diocesan Family School Building Levy, are the responsibility of parents/guardians of students enrolled at the College. The fees are billed annually at the beginning of Term 1, and prompt settlement of this account is appreciated.

Statements are issued the first week of each month. If you do not receive an email, please contact the Finance Office immediately.

## **PAYMENT OF COLLEGE FEES**

College fees can be paid using Direct Debit, Bpay or Eftpos (over the phone).

If you are paying in instalments, then your nominated amount must finalise your account in full by 30 November 2025.

If you choose to pay your College fees annually in one lump sum, then your account must be finalised by 30 June 2025.

To pay using BPay. All information for this method of payment is found on the top right hand corner of your statement. You will need the biller code and your individual reference number.

## RESOURCE FEE

This fee covers all resources required for mandatory and elective subjects.

It covers all incursions/excursions under \$50.00, student diaries, access to internet via Catholic Network Australia, Year 7 calculators (replacement calculators are available for \$30.00) and access to library resources.

Sport fees will now be included in the Resource Fee. The fee covers bus travel, entry fees at the venues, sport coaches, swimming carnival, athletics carnival and various representative sports.

.CONCESSIONS are available to parents who have more than one child attending a Catholic Secondary School in this Diocese.

Concessions are also given to holders of a Health Care/Pension card. A copy of this card must be provided to the Finance Office for this discount to be considered.

Concessions may also be offered in cases of hardship. In this instance an appointment must be made with the Principal each year, and a Fee Concession Application Form must be completed. All discussions and arrangements regarding fees are of course strictly confidential between Parents and Principal.
